WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN NATIONALS AND DANCE WORLD CUP 2023?

WHEN AND WHERE ARE NATIONALS 2023?

July 1 - 3, 2023 - Fairmont Chateau Whistler, BC, Canada.
MacDonald Ballroom (competition stage 40 x 60 w/ Rosco floor)
plus Frontenac Ballroom for workshops and rehearsal space.

WHO CAN COMPETE AT NATIONALS?

All routines that compete at a 5678 Showtime Regional.
There may be invitations if unable to attend a Regional.

ARE THERE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS?

Yes, we encourage dancers to register for the event Package (\$450) which includes convention, outfit, tour, activities, and performance in the Gala Showcase.

WHERE DO COMPETITORS COME FROM?

Competitors normally represent all provinces from across Canada.
CBC recognizes 5678 Showtime as the only official Nationals.

IS THERE A LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES?

There is no limit to the number of entries provided registration is complete with payment by June 1, and there is space available within the scheduled dates of competition.

WHAT ARE THE AGE DIVISIONS & ABILITY LEVELS?

Age divisions (6 & under, 7 - 9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-19; 20-29, 30+) and ability levels (novice, junior, senior) may or may not be divided or combined based on the level of participation.

WHAT ARE THE AWARDS AT NATIONALS?

Crystal trophies for groups; black crystal medals for dancers.
High Score Crystal Trophies for cash award winners.
National cash awards start in multiples of \$2,500 up to \$75,000.

WHEN ARE AWARDS PRESENTED AT NATIONALS?

Trophies and medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place are presented after each session. High score trophies, and cash awards are presented at the end of Nationals. Dancers must be present for High Score and Cash Awards.

What other activities are offered at Nationals and Dance World Cup 2023?

Event Package: Event Package for \$450 includes convention classes (June 1 - 3), 3-piece team outfit, activities in Whistler, and performance in the Gala Showcase July 6. Tour activities for family members is \$175. Contact info@danceworldcup.com for coupon code.

WHO CAN COMPETE AT DANCE WORLD CUP?

Canadians are invited at 5678 Showtime Regionals.
Foreign countries qualify by YouTube or qualifying competitions.

ARE THERE OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS?

CID membership is encouraged. ExecSec@CID-portal.org.
Independent soloists 30 & under pay \$45 US. Studio entries are \$160 US for the studio + \$80 US for the director.

WHERE DO COMPETITORS COME FROM?

Over 7,000 dancers from Europe, Asia, South America, North America, Australia, Africa have competed at DWC since 2008.

IS THERE A LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES?

All routines must be invited; maximum 3 solos per dancer.
Registration is limited within the scheduled time frame, and must be complete with payment by June 1, 2023.

WHAT ARE THE AGES AND ABILITY LEVELS?

Age divisions (6 & under, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16-19, 20-29, 30+) are not divided, but may be combined for Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards. There are no ability levels at Dance World Cup.

WHAT ARE THE AWARDS AT DANCE WORLD CUP?

Gold, Silver, Bronze Octagon crystal medals of Olympic size.
Dance World Cup Crystal Trophies - 20" high for High Score performances, and honorary awards for foreign countries.

WHEN ARE AWARDS PRESENTED AT DWC?

High Score trophies are presented at the Gala Showcase July 6.
The medal awards ceremony is in the evening of July 6.
Results are announced at the award ceremony July 6.
Dancers must be present to receive their awards.
